TENDER NOTICE NO. 6 / REV /THATCH LOT MURSHIDABAD/ 2018-19

The Divisional Forest Officer, Nadia Murshidabad Division Offers for sale of thatch lots through sealed tender as detailed in the scheduled attached under the terms and conditions specified below:

The intending purchasers are requested to submit the tender **ONLY BY COURIER SERVICE/SPEED POST /Registered post to SRI RANA DATTA, I.F.S., Divisional Forest Officer, Nadia Murshidabad Division, OFFICE OF THE DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, ANATHESWAR ROAD, P.O. KRISHNAGAR, DIST. NADIA, PIN 741101.** Tender will be received up to 12:00 Noon on 11/07/2018 No tender will be received by hand or by ordinary post. The tender will be opened on 11/07/2018 at 2:00 p.m. in the presence of purchasers who will be present at that time. Original Tender Form to be submitted Xerox form will not be entertained.

CONDITIONS.

1. The lots will be sold ' as is where is ' basis. The intending purchasers are, therefore, requested to inspect the thatch lots before entry of the tender. Concerned Range Officer, Berhampore (S) Range and Beat Officer Domkal Beat may please be contacted for details of the lots.
2. Tender Form can be purchased(Cost of each Form is Rs. 200.00) from Range Office Berhampore (South) Range from 03/07/2018 To 10/07/2018 on production of application in plain paper along with ST/IT/GSTIN clearance certificate as applicable (up to 2017-18) along with attested copy of PAN Card and VOTER card. No tender will be accepted unless he / she proves that he /she is a citizen of India.

3. Original Tender paper duly filled in shall be attached with E-challan of Rs. 1000.00 (Rupees One thousand only) as earnest money deposit only in original, together with valid clearance certificate of GSTIN and the P.Tax/IT certificate from the concerned office of the area where his business centre is situated, failing which the tender will be rejected. Incomplete Tender paper and illegible Tender paper will liable to be cancelled.
4. The successful purchaser in respect of a particular lot / lots, must deposit 100 % revenue of lot / lots, within 4 (four) days of the tender opened and sign the prescribed agreement form. The revenue of the lot/ lots along with GSTIN., I.Tax, shall have to be deposited to the Range Officer Berhampore (South) Range. In addition security Deposit at the rate of 10% of the total sale value has to be deposited.
5. The Earnest Money of un-successful purchasers and the successful purchaser will be released through Treasury as per existing rule on written prayer after validity of work order is over. If the 1st purchaser fails to pay up 100% of the sale value along with GSTIN and Income Tax according to schedule time, that is within 4 (four) days from the date of completion of tender, an offer may be given to the second highest purchaser. In this case decision of undersigned will be final.
6. The Security Deposit of the successful purchaser will not be released till completion report of work is received from the Range Officer, Berhampore (S) Range.
7. The undersigned is not bound to accept the highest or any offer for any lot and will not assign any reason for acceptance or rejection of any offer for any lot.
8. The sale of any lot, if the value of which exceeds the acceptance power of undersigned shall be provisionally accepted pending confirmation by the Chief Conservator of Forests, South-East Circle, West Bengal and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, West Bengal and the Department of Forests, Government of West Bengal respectively. The offer in respect of such sale shall however be conditionally accepted and all formalities of also shall be done though pending final confirmation. The conditional acceptance shall not enforce or create any right of the offered for confirmation. If the sale is not confirmed by the appropriate authority, the agreement signed by the highest purchaser and the sale will be treated as cancelled.
9. In the event of failure of the successful purchaser to pay 100 % of the offer value for a particular lot and to sign the agreement within stipulated time, the Earnest Money of the successful purchaser will be forfeited to the Government and the purchaser will be debarred from taking part in any tender, in future and will be Black listed.

10. The directorate does not undertake any risk of any damage if the produce of the sold out lots caused by theft, fire, flood, cyclone or other natural calamities or biotic factors.
11. The undersigned or any staff of any duty officer may inspect the lot as and when necessary.
12. The undersigned has the right to withdraw any lot / lots without assigning any reason thereof.
13. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Conservator of Forests, South East Circle, West Bengal will be final and binding to the purchaser.
14. The produce of the lot must be removed from the lot area within 31st January, 2019. In case of delay in removal of the produce a surcharge @ Rs. 2 % only per lot per month will be charged from the purchaser concerned.
15. The purchaser must furnish in writing the names of his authorized agents if any, with the specimen signature and attested copy of identity proof to the Range Officer, Berhampore (S) Range before start the work in the lots. The undersigned has the discretion of accepting or rejecting any agent.
16. The purchaser shall intimate the Range Officer concerned in writing before leave the lot areas as the expiry of the date of agreement. In absence of any such intimation, the purchaser shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to the lots area even after the date of agreement till the date on which such written information is received.
17. In the event of any damage done to the roads, telegraph, electricity line in compound / depot lot fencing due to negligence in loading of produce on the carts or trucks in the site, the purchaser shall be fully responsible to compensate the loss.
18. The purchaser will not be allowed to remove any produce before payment of full Revenue, GSTIN and Income Tax of the purchase lot. All movement of produce must be covered by valid transit pass to be issued by the Range Officer, Barhampore (S) Range / Beat Officer, Domkal Beat.
19. Any contravention of the provisions of IFA, 1927, Wildlife(P) Act, 1972 and rules made there under terms and conditions of the agreement and sale notice on the part of a purchaser or his authorized agent shall also be liable to pay fine or compensation for causing any sort of damage to the trees or any other forest property in the area of the lot during the period of the agreement as fixed by the undersigned. After successful completion of the work and getting completion report from the Range Officer Earnest Money and Security Deposit shall be refunded.

20. Point (1) to (19) form the part of agreement.
21. No disturbance to the ecosystem to be caused.
22. No person without proper identity would be entertained.
