Sealed tenders are invited from bonafide, experienced and reliable contractors for execution of the works as detailed in the schedule attached herewith subject to the following conditions. Tenders should be addressed to the undersigned by name as well as by Official Designation (Sri Nilratan Panda, W.B.F.S., Divisional Forest Officer, Panchet Division.)

CONDITIONS

- 1) Permission for purchase of Tender papers to be obtained by submitting application on production of credentials, Income Tax & Sales Tax clearance Certificates etc.
- 2) Tender Paper will be available in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Panchet Division on payment of **Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) only for Construction of Atchala from 03/07/2017 up to 11/07/2017 within Office time.** The Plan and Estimate of the said works may be seen at the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours.
- 3) Sealed tenders will be received in the office of the undersigned at Bishnupur by REGISTERED POST/COURIER up to 1.00 P.M. on 12/07/2017 and shall be opened on the same day at 4:00 P.M. in presence of the tenderers. if they are willing to be present.
- 4) The Tenderers will have to produce Income Tax, Sales Tax and Professional Tax Clearance Certificates as well as to satisfy the undersigned regarding financial strength, past experience etc. before issuing Tender Paper to them. The intending contractors will have to produce documents showing past experience in building work of similar scale (at least 80% of the Project cost) along with the application for issuing Tender Paper. No documents more than 3(three) years old will be accepted.
- 5) The undersigned is not bound to accept the lowest or any rate quoted and may reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.
- 6) To qualify technically in the Tender, each bidder should have the following criteria:-
 - a) The bidder should have a minimum average annual turnover of least 100% of the estimated project cost of Tender / e-tender in the last three preceding years (the turnover of the lead member will be considered in case of joint venture).
 - b) The bidder should have successfully completed at least one similar type of work during last 3(three) years for a single contract of value not less than 80% .

- c) The bidder should also have made profits after taxes for each of these last 3 financial years.
- 7) The Earnest Money @ 5% of the project cost against NIT as mentioned in the schedule should be deposited through Demand Draft in favor of the Divisional Forest Officer, Panchet Division, Bishnupur and it must be attached with the tender paper.
 - 8) The undersigned reserves the right to demand from the Tenderers the classification and justification of their offer. The item wise statement of their proposed expenditure analysis with a view to construct the work mentioned in the schedule of this Tender Notice. On the item wise expenditure proposed labour cost should be specifically mentioned.
 - 9) Tenderers should inspect the works site prior to submission of tenders. The Plan & Estimate for the work may be obtained from the office of the undersigned during office working hours or may be seen in the notice board.
 - 10) All tools and plants required for the works will have to be supplied by the contractors.
 - 11) Brick work and cement concrete work should be thoroughly cured for at least 14 days (21 days for roof) and to be done as per standard practice, codes and rules. Use of vibrator is obligatory for compaction of cement concrete works.
 - 12) The contractor shall have no claim for any payment before completion of work.
 - 13) The successful tenderers will be required to deposit Security Money 10 % of the project cost in the Form of Treasury Challan T.R. No. 7 to the SBI, Bishnupur. They will also sign the agreement in the prescribed Form within 3 (three) days from the date of acceptance of the tender, failing the Earnest Money will be forfeited to the Government. The work must be completed within 75 (seventy five) days failing which the Security Deposit Money will be forfeited to the Government.
 - 14) The Earnest Money of the successful tenderer will be refunded after depositing Security Deposit Money of the Tenderer in full. The Earnest Money of the unsuccessful tenderer will be released in due course.
 - 15) All works are to be carried out as per plan specification and estimate of works subject to modification made in writing by the undersigned or his authorized Officer & will be completed definitely by 75 (seventy five) days .
 - 16) The **Security Deposit Money** will be released on satisfactory completion of the work after 180 days.
 - 17) The undersigned reserves the right to cancel the contract on the ground of unsatisfactory or delayed work and thereby to forfeited the Security Deposit in the terms of the agreement
 - 18) All materials to be used as per P.W.D. specification and should be approved by the undersigned or his authorized officer before use.
 - 19) The terms and condition mentioned herein shall be deemed to form a part of the agreement.
 - 20) In accordance with the provision of relevant Section of Income Tax 1951. Deduction of Income Tax @ 2% shall be made from the gross value of the bill.
 - 21) Commercial Tax (Sales Tax/VAT or any other Tax applicable) at the prevailing rates as per the provision of section 6 E of Bengal Finance (Sales Tax/VAT) Act, 1941, Labour Welfare Cess or any other extant Tax's will be deducted from the bills of the contractor .
 - 22) If any terms and conditions of the tender are altered the same will be notified.

- 23) The work will be executed under the direct supervision or the concerned Range Officer or Beat Officer.
- 24) The successful tenderer will have to undertake such extra work (not specified in the Tender) which he would subsequently be asked to do in writing by the undersigned, the payment for such extra work "will be made as per the rate of the current P W D schedule applicable to Bankura District less the rate quoted by tender.
- 25) The acceptance of the Tender will be subject to the receipt of approval of higher authority. The undersigned will not be responsible for any loss sustained by a tenderer in the event of non-receipt of Govt. Sanction


