ANALYSIS OF THE ESTIMATE

1. The quoted rate is exclusive of GST, carriage of the materials up to the site. Intending bidders are required to quote their accordingly. All statutory deductions, as applicable, shall be deducted from the accepted quoted rate.
2. Sample of all the materials to be supplied are required to be placed before tender/Quotation Committee constituted for the purpose. Only the approved materials shall be allowed to supply. No deviation from the sample shown and accepted by the tender/quotation committee shall be allowed under any circumstances; subject to discretionary power of the undersigned.
3. **Work should be completed within 15 days from the date of issue of work order. Payment shall be made based on the accepted rate and actual supply of the materials at field. A security deposit to the tune of 10% of the accepted offered rate shall have to be provided by the successful bidder/s concerned. In case of any delay or supply of poor quality of the materials, penalty to the tune of 15% in shall be awarded subject to the discretionary power of the undersigned. Prayer of reduction of security can also be accepted subject to the discretionary power of the undersigned.**

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Quotation is floated with an anticipation of administrative and financial approval from appropriate authority. If approval is not received or fund is not there, the quotation shall be cancelled outright without assigning any further reason. Work order, after completion of due formalities shall be issued accordingly. Payment for availing quotation paper, if any shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
2. Intending Bidders may participate in maximum 10 (ten) clusters of his choice; subject to having the requisite financial credentials of similar nature of job in this regard.
3. **As per latest G.O No-4608-F(Y) dt 18/7/18, if the accepted rate is quoted below 20%, then an additional security in the form of Bank Guarantee to the tune of 10% of estimated cost shall required to be deposited by the successful bidder.**
4. **The location shown in the tender notice are indicative in nature. Location may vary as per exact field situation. Successful bidder/s shall have to make their own arrangement to carry out the works in new location on their own. No claim of excess payment shall be entertained in such cases.**
5. **Eligibility Criteria-** Model estimates and legal and technical documents as per the item of works mentioned against the item of work must be submitted along with technical documents. The financial credential must be at **least 60%** of each cluster in which the intending bidder/s is willing to participate. The credential (Both Model & Financial should not be more than 3 years old and it should not be for more than 3 contracts.
6. **Submission of Security-** Security, as mentioned in the schedule, should be submitted before issuance of the works order by the successful bidders, as per existing rules. Security may also be adjusted with the R.A Bills to be paid for the successful implementation of the works. The mode of security deposit shall finally be decided by the undersigned. 9. **Rate quoted should be inclusive of all Taxes.**
10. **Intending bidder/s shall be allowed to participate in any or all of the clusters, subject to having the requisite financial potential which should be at least 60 % of estimate for each cluster for which the intending bidder/s is willing to participate.**
11. **Intending bidders shall have to quote the rate only. 17. **Work should be done within 7 (Seven) days from the date of issue of work order.**

19. **It shall be the discretionary power of the undersigned to impose penalty to the tune of 10% of the total value of the work in case of delay in completing the work, if applicable**
20. The quotationer/supplier/contractor should have valid license from concerned authority.
21. **Sample, if applicable, should be supplied to the AFR section before quoting the rate through quotation.**
22. Broken / Damaged materials / materials of below quality against the sample supplied, if found after receiving by this office, the same should be replaced with new one / fresh supply at the earliest.
23. Guarantee / Warranty of the supplied materials if any, should be indicated in the quotation.
24. Delivery of the materials should be free of cost.
25. The rate offered should be valid for 3(three) months. However the same can be increased up to 1 year subject to satisfactory service of the quotationer.
26. Actual work at field level shall be dependent on the field level situation as per recommendation of the concerned Range Officer. Payment will be made based on actual supply / work done.
27. It shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to pay minimum wages to the labourers engaged for the work. In no case minimum wages shall be compromised under any circumstances.
28. Concerned Range Officer will be at his liberty to engage skill labourers from among the FPCs; but payment as per minimum wage act, shall be required to be made by the contractor concerned.
29. If required, and if decided by the Range Officer concerned, payment to the labourers shall be given directly to the respective bank accounts of the labourers. Successful bidder shall not have any say regarding the matter.
30. In that case bill shall be prepared accordingly based on the certificate provided by the concerned Range Officer in this regard referring the same quotation no. & work order no.
31. Work order will be issued to the successful quotationer as and when required and subject to availability of fund from appropriate authority.

Analysis of the Estimates
