Activities of Monitoring & Evaluation wing:

NEW MONITORING METHODOLOGY:

This was the method followed till last year. But from current year onwards the new methodology as approved by PCCF(HoFF), West Bengal will be followed to make it more holistic. The purpose of this new methodology is to **evaluate**the plantations **Holistically**, **Objectively and Comprehensively** across **10** parameters with due weightage to these parameters considering their importance.

All these ten parameters have been divided into three broad Categories

 Conformity Parameters- 4 nos 12 points (Confirming to the Working Plan & other prescriptions)

Execution parameters -4nos20 points

(Process of raising the Plantation)

 Performance Parameters-2nos 68 points (Result of the Plantation)
